

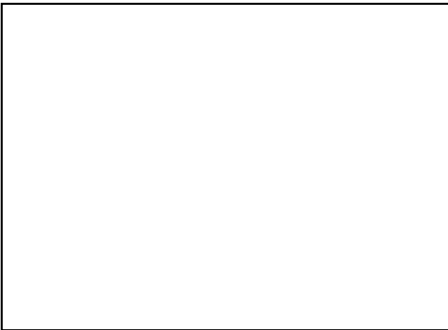

FELINE SURGERY CONSENT FORM

1. PRE-OP SCREENING: Your pet is with us for a procedure that will require a sedative and/or anesthesia. For all cats, we RECOMMEND a pre-op profile to check for adequate numbers of blood cells and possible problems in the kidneys and liver, which may not be evident upon a physical examination. For cats 7 years and old, this testing is REQUIRED. (Cost approx \$96)

- YES -- Please complete recommended pre-op testing.
NO -- My pet is under 7 years old. I DECLINE recommended pre-op testing, but perform the procedure.



2. SEVOFLO ANESTHESIA OPTION: We use Isoflurane anesthesia, which has an excellent safety record. You may also elect Sevoflo anesthesia. Sevoflo is an anesthetic used for 95% of human pediatric procedures in the US. Its advantages are rapid and smooth induction and recovery with no "anesthesia hangover." There is an additional cost of \$1.00 per minute of anesthesia time for Sevoflo. This is in addition to the normal anesthesia charge

- YES -- I authorize the use of Sevoflo if appropriate in my pet's procedure and agree to pay the additional charge.
NO -- I decline this service.

3. INTRAVENOUS CATHETER AND FLUIDS: Kidney disease is common in cats. Unfortunately, it can be difficult to detect in the early stages. We can help protect kidney function and maintain blood pressure with an IV catheter to administer fluids during anesthesia. An IV catheter also gives us direct access to the veins in the unlikely event of a crisis. We STRONGLY RECOMMEND that all cats undergoing anesthesia have an IV catheter. (Cost approx \$68)

- YES -- I authorize the use of an IV catheter and fluids during my pet's procedure.
NO -- I decline this service.

4. RECOMMENDED TESTS:

- YES -- please provide a fecal exam for my pet. (Cost approx \$24.) Recommended for all cats that have not been tested within the last year.
YES -- please test my cat for both the Feline Leukemia Virus and the FIV Virus. (Cost approx \$66) Recommended for both indoor cats that have not been tested and for all outdoor cats.

5. VACCINES*: We require that all pets be current on their Rabies and Distemper vaccinations. There may be an exam charge if vaccines are given.

- YES -- Please administer the following vaccines: Distemper Rabies Leukemia Virus

*Occasionally, a pet can have a reaction to a vaccine. This reaction can be as mild as a few hours of slightly lethargic behavior to, in very rare cases, death from anaphylactic shock. It is impossible to predict which pets will react to vaccines. However, we will make every effort to treat your pet should a reaction occur. If you know your pet has had a vaccine reaction in the past, please let your doctor know so we can take precautions.

6. PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION: We can implant a microchip on your pet for an ID that can't get lost! This simple procedure can be performed while your pet is here today. The cost for the surgical implantation of the chip is \$61.20.
